## MEN & LADIES SINGLES COMPETITION CONDITIONS OF PLAY

**All matches will be played in line with the Crystal Mark 4 edition of the laws.**

**Markers will be appointed by the organiser for all matches.**

**Rinks will be drawn prior to commencement of all matches.**

**Two trial ends are allowed.**

**There are no restrictions on visiting the head.**

**The winner being the first to score 21 shots.**

**Losers should be available to mark in the next round.**

**Bowls stickers must be all same or none at all.**

**Replacements are not allowed once the draw has been made and published.**

**“No show” or in excess of 15 minutes late then the match will be awarded to the opponent.**

**Curtailment of Play Due: to weather and with the agreement of the controlling body, the following conditions will apply:**

**If play is suspended, and cannot continue on the same day, provided 15 ends have been played, the game shall be considered to be completed and the scores count. If at that stage the game is drawn, the result will be determined by the scores on the penultimate end.**

### **Withdrawing from Competitions**

**Once a draw has been carried out, competitors who withdraw from F.A.B. Competitions without an acceptable reason may be subject to sanctions such as a limited suspension from future F.A.B. Competitions. Bowlers are reminded not to enter tournaments if they feel that they are not able to play in all rounds and finals. Any penalties will be decided by the F.A.B. Committee in each individual case.**
